

Swine Nutritionist

This exempt full-time position reports to the Director of Operations. The Swine Nutritionist provides local leadership in scientific knowledge, technical support, and best practice to Topigs Norsvin USA (TNUSA) and Topigs Norsvin Canada (TNCAN). The Swine Nutritionist provides customer service and sales support; and coordinates and oversees local research and product evaluation related to the nutrition of Topigs Norsvin breeding sows, breeding boars, and commercial pigs. Specifically, this position is responsible for the feeding and nutritional recommendations of pigs raised and managed by Topigs Norsvin partners. This position requires attendance and participation in scientific conferences, trade shows, meetings with the greater Topigs Norsvin organization, and other industry events on an as-needed basis not specifically outlined in this description. This position demands an individual who is willing to collaborate with all team members to provide excellent service to TNUSA and TNCAN customers. A commitment to maintain the confidential nature of TNUSA, TNCAN, and Topigs Norsvin International (TNI) company business is essential.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS

Allied Industry Support (75%-time expenditure)

- Sales and Marketing Support
 - Participate in Key Account Management teams, especially related to Global Key Accounts and integrated customer accounts.
 - Write / edit / review technical literature for use in North America including nutritional manuals, production manuals, newsletters, and other technical reports.
 - Communicate directly with the Director of Sales and Director of Technical Services to provide technical responses to customer questions, concerns, challenges, and opportunities to support the sales and technical teams.
- Provide technical service support to multiplier, InGene, and commercial producers to monitor feed and nutrition for optimum performance.

Research and Product Development (15%-time expenditure)

- Conduct and provide scientific oversight for local nutrition, nutrition related, and technical support research trials.
 - Be a member of Trial, Data Analysis Team (TDAT) to collect, analyze, summarize, and disseminate customer field data, trial data, and research data then convert to tools for support and marketing.
- Participate in Global Nutrition Platform activities.
 - Bridge the gap between the local and global nutrition team to facilitate exchange of knowledge.
 - o Participate on Global Nutrition Services teams.
 - Represent Topigs Norsvin at USA scientific meetings, conferences, and trade shows.

Work Environment

The Swine Nutritionist works in a production facility and in an office environment.

Physical Demands

This position requires the ability to move about within a production facility as necessary to support on farm research trials, data collection in production barns, and other similar tasks. Frequent bending, kneeling, and/or sitting for extended periods is required. The ability to lift 50 lbs is required.

Travel

This position is US based and requires the ability to travel among the various TNUSA and TNCAN customer and company facilities and, as such, requires a current valid driver's license. International travel will be required. Swine Nutritionist must follow the TNUSA Travel Policy guidelines. This position requires approximately 50% travel for work in the field and 25% travel for work in the offices of TNUSA, TNCAN, and TNI. Some travel will be required outside normal business hours and weekends.
